Selection will be based on scholarship, citizenship, need, service, and leadership. The student must be a graduating senior from Morristown High School who has been accepted to an institution of higher learning. Boys and girls are eligible. Applicants who are the child, grandchild, or great-grandchild of a veteran or Auxiliary member will be given preference.
